




Safety Segregation

- All works will be carried out behind site hoardings to ensure safe segregation of the works from local residents and the general public.
- Hoardings will be in place around the Camden Road site.
- Community Notice Board will be updated with pictures of the project and newsletters.










Hoarding

- Morgan Sindall will secure the site once in possession
- There will be a protective mesh barrier installed along the boundary walls either side of site
- The hoarding along the pavement elevation will largely follow a similar design











Safety

- One vehicle entry and exit gate, North end of site.
- All construction vehicles will be reversed in from Camden Road under the control of traffic marshals.
- Retractable gate to be positioned across the pavement as vehicle arrives and leaves site.





Working Hours

The site will be open Monday to Friday: 08:00 - 18:00 Saturday: 08:00 - 13:00 Sunday and Bank Holidays: Closed


All site operatives will arrive on site between 07:30 – 08:00 but will not start works until 08:00. Site operatives will stop at 18:00 and will leave site by 18:30, once they are cleaned and changed.



Logistics and Deliveries

- All delivery drivers will be registered with either CLOCS or FORS which is an advanced awareness course.
- Permitted Delivery Times: 08:00 – 18:00.
- Morgan Sindall will limit deliveries to 09:30 – 15:00 during less busy periods as far as possible





Logistics and Deliveries

- There is no parking on site. No personnel will park in neighbouring streets.
- All deliveries are booked into a delivery management schedule only one delivery will arrive on site at any one time.
- No deliveries will be waiting outside of the site hoarding, our site gate teams will bring deliveries straight into site.
- All vehicles brought into site are under the control of a Traffic Marshall.



Logistics and Deliveries

- A delivery route to site has been agreed with London Borough of Camden Highways.
- Vehicles will approach site from the North via the A1. Turn right onto A503 and travel down Camden Road (Green).
- Vehicles will then leave site via the same route, travelling back up North on the A1 (Red).





Noise

- Construction methods will be selected to mitigate noise e.g. piles will be bored instead of driven.
- Where possible, materials will be manufactured off site to reduce noise.
- All construction plant will be selected on lowest noise levels, electric or battery plant in preference to diesel.
- Acoustic screening will be used around any particularly noisy construction activities where possible.
- Where possible, materials will be lifted in place by the tower crane to keep noise down.
- As a last resort, noise meters are installed around the site to monitor the noise levels of works.





Vibrations

- Construction methods will be selected that reduce vibration e.g. bored piles instead of driven.
- All plant has been selected with mechanical measures to limit vibration.
- We will select construction plant with longer reaches to reduce the amount of times if needs to move on site.
- All piles will be cropped as opposed to broken out.





Dust

- Dust will be controlled at source, activities will be carried out in a manner to preclude dust generation.
- Dust levels will be controlled by damping down the works with water where there is a risk of dust.
- Additional screening will be erected around any works likely to cause dust (Majority of Demolition already completed).
- Our traffic marshals will jet wash vehicles before leaving site to reduce the risk of debris onto the public highway.

Initial Works on site

- Site Enabling works: • Site Establishment to Piling Mat.
- Erection of remaining hoardings and • Site Welfare set up.
- Removal of remaining below ground ulletfoundations.
- Boundary wall works.







No.246 Camden Road and No.95a Camden Mews Boundary Wall.

Duration: 3 weeks

Access to the Garden Areas will be prohibited during this time due to excavation works.





Demolish remaining brickwork in garden (No.246)







• Remove remaining lowlevel brickwork using small excavator on site side.

Demolish remaining brickwork in garden (No.95a Camden Mews)






- Remove remaining low-level brickwork using small excavator on site side.
- Paying close attention to AC unit and conservatory.
- Duration: 2 days.
- Please note garden will be closed during these works.

Garden Wall to be demolished


Duration 2 days


Section of stairs to be removed to accommodate new foundation

Cast new brickwork foundations (No.246)





- Cast new wall foundation in 246 garden boundary.
- Cast new foundation adjacent to stairs.
- Build first brick courses to bring up to ground level so as not to clash with Sheet Piling Rig.



Camden

Reinstate hoarding along Boundary Line





- New brickwork will be left 500mm high from Ground Level.
- Rest of wall will be completed towards the end of the project once Disabled Unit is completed. (Step 7 on following slide)
- Re-instate hoarding and open garden




Step 2

Partial demolition No.252 Camden Road and No.101 Camden Mews boundary.

Duration: 1 week

Happening concurrently with No.246 side.



Install localised segregation within garden (No.252 and No. 101 Camden Mews)

- Install heras fencing or ulletpedestrian barriers locally within the garden to make secure
- Include signage and fencing ۲ clips



No.246 Scaffold – March 2025




- Protective scaffold walkway to be installed along garden pathway of 252 Camden Road.
- Scaffold will be double boarded for thorough protective measures to residents.
- Walkway to be protected in the early stages of the project.
 Main scaffold to be erected once frame is constructed.
