### **Central Somers Town**

This project consists of 34 apartments over 2 low-rise blocks with a new Community Hall.

#### What work have we done so far?

We have enclosed the site within a hoarding, demolished the existing Community Hall, reduced the level across the site, and established a temporary haul road into the site. We have also now installed our Cabins.

# What work is coming up next month?

- Breaking out concrete obstructions in the ground which are on future pile positions, these are foundations from the site's previous use by the railway as a coal distribution yard.
- Establish a temporary platform across the site for the piling rig to work from.
- Commence piling at the end of May.
