


Progress, lookahead and community engagement

- Upgrading of the haul road and pile mat
- Removal of Wall to North Boundary
- Moving of Hoarding to East Boundary



Up-coming works

- Continue reinforced concrete frame to Block A
- Installation of Sheet Piling
- Excavate Block B Basement and commence sub-structure works to the basement including the basement slab and reinforced concrete walls
- Sub-structure works to the hall and Block D, including forming levels and pouring of concrete foundations
- · Continue drainage install across the site
- Erection of tower crane



Community Engagement


