Statement of the Representations Procedure

This notice is provided in accordance with Regulation 19 of the Town and Country Planning (Local Development) (England) (Amendment) Regulations 2012.

'The Camden Local Plan - Submission Draft 2016' is the title of the document which the Council intends to submit to the Secretary of State. The plan sets out the Council's planning policies and vision for the development of Camden over the next 15 years and planning policies. It will form the basis for Council's decisions on planning applications and set the framework for future development in the borough.

Representations can be made over an eight week consultation period from 8 February 2016 to 4 April 2016
