## What Personal Data will we collect about you and for what purpose?

We are collecting feedback from residents and stakeholders for a green space improvement project on Phoenix Road in Somers Town. This is part of Camden's work to address the loss of open space resulting from the construction of High Speed 2.

We are collecting personal contact data so we can feedback to participants with the findings of the engagement and to keep them informed of project progress.
