We, Groundwork London are known as the 'Processor' of your data which means we take instructions from Camden Council who control how your data is used.

By providing your postcode and demographic, gender, age and disability data, you consent to Groundwork London sharing your personal data with Camden Council for the purpose of the Phoenix Road consultation. All data collected is anonymised before sharing with Camden Council. Your personal information will not be shared for purposes other than those stated above unless you agree to it at a later time.

We may store your data with countries outside the UK; however, these will only be ones which have the same privacy standards required by the EU for its residents.

Groundwork London is required by Camden Council to keep your data for the duration of the project and for two years following completion. Your data will be destroyed by Groundwork London on completion of this timeframe.
