OUTCOME OF THE CAMDEN HIGH STREET CONSULTATION

Last summer, we asked for your views on our proposals to trial a motor traffic-free section of Camden High Street and changes to key streets around Camden High Street. Thank you to everyone who took the time to share their feedback.



We asked you how you would feel about this trial that would aim to create a vibrant, activated High Street at the heart of Camden Town. Following the consultation, Camden has decided to go ahead with the trial. This includes the following changes:

- A motor traffic-free zone on Camden High Street from the junction with Parkway and Kentish Town Road to the junction with Hawley Crescent and Jamestown Road
- New loading and delivery areas on the roads surrounding Camden High Street
- · New blue badge parking bays on Buck Street
- New Streateries and loading bays on Jamestown Road

WHAT TO EXPECT DURING THE TRIAL

We received enormous excitement from residents, businesses, and visitors about the proposals. These changes will aim to create safer, healthier, and more pleasant public places in Camden Town and will open up the space to launch an exciting programme of events that celebrate Camden's communities, rich history and grassroots culture. This cultural programme is expected to begin later in 2025, and we'll publish more details soon.
