

Making your streets safer and healthier

In March 2022 we consulted on whether to make the trial changes on College Place permanent to make it easier to travel by bike between Plender Street and Royal College Street. Thank you to everyone who shared their views. We have decided to make the following permanent changes:

- Keeping northbound cycling between Royal College Street and Plender Street
- Keeping the traffic islands to separate northbound cyclists at the junctions of Plender Street
- Keeping signage and on street cycle symbols and other markings showing permitted cycle route.
- Keeping waiting and loading prohibitions (double yellow lines with double kerb blips) around the junctions with Plender Street and Royal College Street

We will also be making these new permanent changes by the end of the year:

- Adding double yellow lines and double painted blips to the three raised crossing areas on College Place between Plender Street and Royal College Street, to discourage parking and make it easier for people to cross the street.
