What personal data will we collect about you and for what purpose?

Following previous consultations with residents, we want to find out what green spaces the community would like to see refreshed. The Council's priority for future work will be those where residents are most affected by the High Speed 2 construction works.

We are working with Groundwork London in asking residents what their ideas and priorities are for local green spaces. Our main aim is to find out what improvements would most benefit local residents so we can propose new designs.

Groundwork London will collect and share e-mail addresses of people who e-mail (greenspaces@groundwork.org.uk). They will ask people to sign in (name, e-mail, block name) at Pop Up events and focus groups, walk about and workshops with various groups (over 18s only). This information will only be shared with agreement.

Groundwork London are collecting some Special Category data (disability and ethnicity), with residents agreement only, as part of Equalities Monitoring form. This information will be used to help us identify if a broad range of residents has been reached and to target groups where views have not been represented or under represented.

All data collected will only be used for the purpose of this project.
