Permanent changes now in place



Making your streets safer and healthier

In March 2022 we consulted on whether to make the trial changes on Huntley Street permanent to make it easier to travel by bike between Chenies Street and Torrington Street. Thank you to everyone who shared their views. We have now made the following permanent changes:

- Keeping northbound cycling on Huntley Street between Chenies Street and Torrington Place.
- Keeping signage, on street cycle symbols and other markings showing permitted cycle route, including short sections of cycle lane markings at the junctions with Chenies Street and Torrington Place to protect northbound cyclists.
- Keeping waiting and loading prohibitions (double yellow lines with double kerb blips) around the junctions with Chenies Street and Torrington Place.
- Permanently relocating 1 disabled parking bay and 1 pay to park parking bay, and permanently remove of 1 resident permit holder parking bay (all at junction with Chenies Street).
