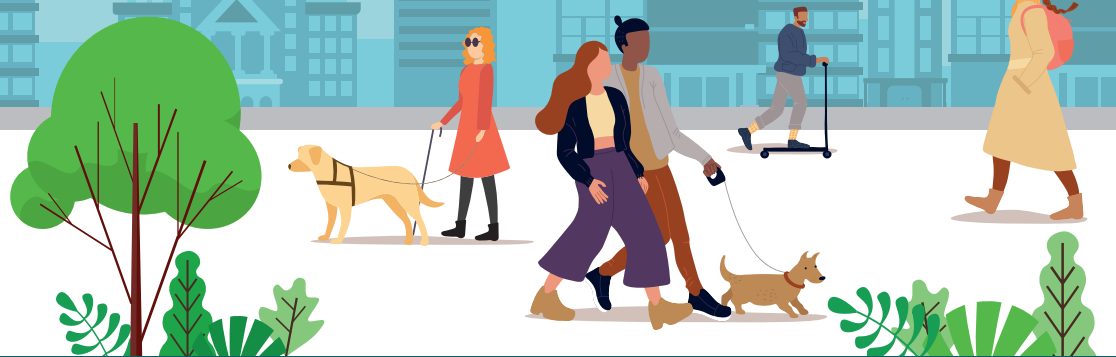


Healthy School Streets

Marsden Street

Update on our plans to create safer and healthier streets in your area



Thank you for your comments

During January and February 2022 we ran a consultation on whether we should make the trial Healthy School Street on Marsden Street permanent. Thank you to everyone who took the time to share their views. We had 32 responses to our consultation. What is being made permanent?

The permanent changes now restrict motor vehicles from entering Marsden Street (with exemptions) during the following times:

- 8.30am - 9.30am and 3pm - 4pm, Monday to Friday during term time only.

We will also be installing a raised section of road and extending the pavement to narrow the crossing and improve safety at the junction of Marsden Street and Talacre Road. The waiting restrictions introduced as part of the trial will remain.

Exemptions

Exemptions for the scheme are available for residents and businesses on Marsden Street, as well as Blue Badge holders that require access. Other exemptions (including temporary or one off exemptions) may be agreed with the council on a case by case basis.
