New rain gardens for Parliament Hill

In October we consulted on whether to add 2 rain gardens on Parliament hill to capture and store rainwater, act as great local habitats for wildlife, and improve the look and feel of the area. Thank you to everyone who took the time to share their views. We had 55 responses and have now decided to go ahead with the installation. Construction on the rain gardens will start on 6 November and is due to be completed by the end of November 2023.

We know how important it is to reduce disruption through roads being dug up so we are working in partnership with Cadent Gas to add in the new rain gardens while they carry out their own work to upgrade metal gas pipes to safer and more reliable plastic pipes. This will save 2 weeks of disruption. Cadent's work begun16 October and they will also write to you on what their work will include. Cadent aim to be finished in early December 2023.

Marlborough Highways are the contractor for the rain gardens and will endeavour to keep disruption to a minimum but some increase in noise, vehicles and pedestrian movements cannot be avoided.
