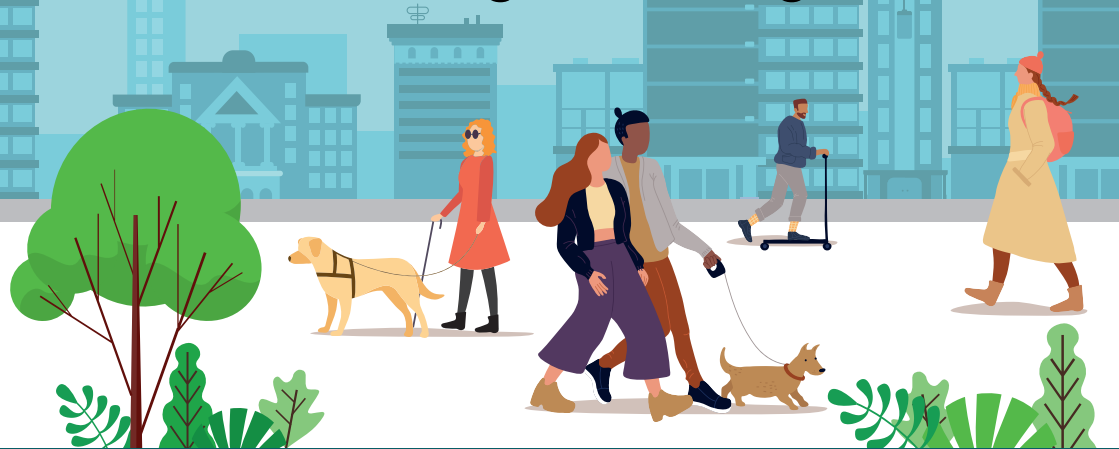


Your Safe and Healthy Streets - December 2021

Savernake and Cressy Road Permanent changes coming soon



Making your streets safer and healthier

In July 2021 we consulted on whether to make the trial through traffic restriction on Savernake Road permanent alongside a new proposal for cycling improvements on Cressy Road and a new Electric Vehicle Charging Point (EVCP) on Savernake Road. Thank you to everyone who took the time to share their views. We have now decided to make the following permanent changes:

- Keep the through-traffic restriction on Savernake Road to stop vehicles from cutting through between Constantine Road and Mansfield Road.
- Extend the pavement to create more space for pedestrians and add new trees and planting.
- Introduce two-way cycling on Cressy Road, to the north of Agincourt Road, to improve cycle permeability.
- Introduce a new EVCP on Savernake Road, at the junction with Estelle Road.
