

Permanent changes now in place

Making your streets safer and healthier

In March 2022 we consulted on whether to make the trial changes on Tottenham Street permanent to make it easier to travel by bike between Cleveland Street and Whitfield Street. Thank you to everyone who shared their views. We have now made the following permanent changes:

- Keeping eastbound cycling between Cleveland Street and Charlotte Street.
- Keeping westbound cycling between Whitfield Street and Charlotte Street.
- Keeping signage, on street cycle symbols and other markings to show permitted cycle route.
- Keeping waiting and loading prohibitions (double yellow lines with double kerb blips) on Tottenham Street, including at the junctions with Charlotte Street, Charlotte Mews, Cleveland Street, Goodge Place, Tottenham Mews and Whitfield Street.
- Permanently changing parking including removing 3.6 metres of resident permit holders parking bay, 2.1 metres of motorcycle parking bay as well as removing 2 disabled parking bays and relocating 1 disabled parking bay.
